

SALARY COMMISSION

02/11/10

Purpose: Establish the salaries of all County elected officials and appointed directors and deputy directors of departments and executive agencies so that their total salaries and benefits have a reasonable relationship to the compensation in the public and private sectors.

Authority: Hawai'i County Charter, Section 13-28, as amended.

Appointment: Mayor with Council approval.
Normal five-year staggered terms.

Full Membership: Nine members.

Ex-Officio Members: Director and Deputy Director of Human Resources.

Specific Representation: One member from each council district.

Requirements: No more than five members may belong to same political party.

Meetings: Subject to the call of the chair, but at least once annually.
Generally held at 10:00 a.m., Liquor Control Conference Room, Hilo.

Financial Disclosure: Members must file Financial Disclosure within 20 working days of taking the oath of office. Thereafter, annual disclosures must be filed on or before January 31. The disclosures are confidential and will be kept on file by the Board of Ethics. County Code, Chapter 2, Section 2-91.1.

Reappointment: Following the expiration of a term, no member may be reappointed for at least two years.

Qualities: Able to focus on the community needs as a whole without catering to special or self-interest, while pursuing its charter mandate as described in "Purpose" above.
