Authority: Hawaii Revised Statutes, Section 367-4.

Appointment: Mayor, no confirmation required. Normal four-year staggered terms.

Full Membership: No specific number. (Must be divisible by three).

Ex-Officio Members: The county attorney or corporation counsel and the county representative of the Commission on the Status of Women.

Specific Representation: None required.

Requirements: Interest in and knowledge of matters relating to women.

Meetings: At least four per year. Usually monthly.

Financial Disclosure: Not required.

Reappointment: Per Mayor's discretion.

Qualities: Respected by the community as being community-minded and oriented. Able to focus on the community needs as a whole without catering to special or self-interest.
